2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE CHILDHOOD INFLUENZA
3 VACCINATIONS UNDER THE STATE'S UNIVERSAL CHILDHOOD VACCINE
4 DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT SELECT
5 COMMITTEE ON EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND DISASTER MANAGEMENT
6 RECOVERY.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
9 Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of seven hundred nine
10 thousand two hundred ninety-six dollars (\$709,296) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum
11 of one million four hundred eighteen thousand five hundred ninety-two dollars (\$1,418,592) for
12 the 2010-2011 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to provide influenza vaccinations to
13 six-year-olds in this State during the 2009-2010 fiscal year and to six-year-olds and
14 seven-year-olds in this State during the 2010-2011 fiscal year.

15 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
