13 14 **SECTION 1.** Article 1 of Chapter 10B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 10B-71. Certain notarial acts validated when recommissioned notary failed to again take oath.

Any acknowledgment taken and any instrument notarized by a person who after recommissioning failed to again take the oath as a notary public is hereby validated. The acknowledgment and instrument shall have the same legal effect as if the person qualified as a notary public at the time the person performed the act. This section shall apply to notarial acts performed on or after May 15, 2004, and before March 10, 2009."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
