A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE EXEMPTION FOR THE TOWN OF LOUISBURG FROM THE
COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE LOUISBURG ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND AN EXEMPTION FROM THE COMPETITIVE
BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR CURRITUCK COUNTY FOR A SINGLE PROJECT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of S.L. 2007-216 reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 3 of this act shall expire
January 1, ~~2009-2011.~~"

SECTION 2. The provisions of Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes do
not apply to a facility for public recreation, senior activities and other public uses to be built by
Currituck County.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
