2 AN ACT TO EXTEND THE EXEMPTION FOR THE TOWN OF LOUISBURG FROM THE
3 COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE LOUISBURG ECONOMIC
4 DEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND AN EXEMPTION FROM THE COMPETITIVE
5 BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR CURRITUCK COUNTY FOR A SINGLE PROJECT.
6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7 **SECTION 1.** Section 4 of S.L. 2007-216 reads as rewritten:
8 "**SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 3 of this act shall expire
9 January 1, ~~2009-2011.~~"
10 **SECTION 2.** The provisions of Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes do
11 not apply to a facility for public recreation, senior activities and other public uses to be built by
12 Currituck County.
13 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
