## GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA SESSION 2009

## SESSION LAW 2009-46 HOUSE BILL 65

AN ACT TO REENACT AND CLARIFY THE STATUTE AUTHORIZING INTELLECTUALLY GIFTED STUDENTS UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN TO ATTEND COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 4 of S.L. 2001-312, as rewritten by Section 2 of S.L. 2005-77, reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 4. Section 2 of this act is effective when it becomes law, and shall apply beginning with the 2001-2002 academic year. Section 2 of this act expires September 1, 2008. September 1, 2008, and is reenacted effective March 1, 2009. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
