4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the
7 following table:

32 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge for
33 District 19A authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the 2010
34 election for a four-year term commencing January 1, 2011.

35 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
36 Department the sum of eighty-four thousand three hundred sixty-three dollars (\$84,363) for the
37 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred fifty thousand one hundred eight dollars
38 (\$150,108) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to fund the additional district court judgeship
39 authorized by this act.

40 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2010.
