A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO TEST FOR HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES
ASSOCIATED WITH THE YADKIN PROJECT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to test for hazardous substances associated with the Yadkin Project No. 2197 as described in a license issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission as of May 1, 1958, and as thereafter amended and otherwise subject to the regulation of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

SECTION 2. The Department shall report the results of the testing required by Section 1 of this act to the Environmental Review Commission no later than December 1, 2010.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
