A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE VARIOUS  
SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:

...

(10b) Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal Recipient. – Issuable to a recipient of the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal. The plate shall bear the phrase "Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal" and a representation of the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.

...

(14d) Boy Scouts of America. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Boy Scouts of America" and an emblem representing the Boy Scouts of America.

...

~~(14a)~~(14f) Brain Injury Awareness. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Brain Injury Awareness" and the logo of the nonprofit group Brain Injury Association of North Carolina, Inc.

(18b) Carolinas Golf Association. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.81. The plate shall bear the phrase "Carolinas Golf Association" and an emblem of the Carolinas Golf Association.

(34c) Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden" with a logo designed by the Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden Foundation, Inc.

(45b) First in Turf. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the words "First in Turf."

12           Market. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision  
13           unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.

- 15           ~~(54) Gold Star Lapel Button. – Issuable to the recipient of the Gold Star lapel~~  
16           ~~button. The plate shall bear the emblem of the Gold Star lapel button and the~~  
17           ~~words "Gold Star".~~

- 19           (56c) Home of American Golf. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor  
20           vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase  
21           "Home of American Golf" and include the Pinehurst logo and a  
22           representation relating to golf.

- 24           (60c) Jaycees. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance  
25           with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Jaycees" and a logo  
26           designed by the North Carolina Jaycees.  
27           ...
- 28           (72c) Mayor. – Issuable to the mayor of a municipality in this State. The plate  
29           shall bear the phrase "Mayor" and the letter "M" followed by a number that  
30           indicates the municipality the mayor serves. The number of a municipality is  
31           the order of the municipality in an alphabetical list of municipalities that  
32           assigns number one to the first municipality in the list. The Division may not  
33           issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300  
34           applications for the plate.  
35           ...
- 36           (77c) Municipal Council. – Issuable to a municipal council member,  
37           commissioner, or alderman of a municipality in this State. The plate shall  
38           bear the words "Council Member," "Commissioner," or "Alderman,"  
39           followed first by a number representing the council member's municipality  
40           and then by a letter or number that distinguishes plates issued to council  
41           members of the same municipality. The number of a municipality shall be  
42           the order of the municipality in an alphabetical list of municipalities that  
43           assigns number one to the first municipality in the list. The Division may not  
44           issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300  
45           applications for the plate.  
46           ...
- 47           (85b) NC Horse Council. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in  
48           accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "NC Horse  
49           Council" and a logo designed by the North Carolina Horse Council, Inc.  
50           ...

- 1           ~~(85a)~~(85d) NC Tennis Foundation. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor  
2           vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase  
3           "Play Tennis" and the image of an implement of the tennis sport.  
4           ...
- 5           (86c) NC Wildlife Federation. – Issuable in the registered owner of a motor  
6           vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear a logo  
7           designed by the North Carolina Wildlife Federation, Inc.  
8           ...
- 9           (88c) North Carolina Master Gardener. – Issuable to the registered owner of a  
10          motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the  
11          letters "MG" with a logo representing the North Carolina Master Gardeners.  
12          ...
- 13          (95b) P.E.O. Sisterhood. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in  
14          accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "P.E.O." and  
15          a logo designed by P.E.O. International.  
16          ...
- 17          (96c) Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor  
18          vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase  
19          "Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity" and the logo of the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity,  
20          Inc.  
21          ...
- 22          (108c) School Board. – Issuable to a school board member in this State. The plate  
23          shall bear the words "School Board" followed first by a number representing  
24          the school board and then by a letter or number that distinguishes plates  
25          issued to members of the same board. The number of a school board shall be  
26          the order of the school board in an alphabetical list of school boards that  
27          assigns number one to the first school board in the list. The Division may not  
28          issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300  
29          applications for the plate.  
30          ...
- 31          (119b) S.T.A.R. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance  
32          with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "For the Love of Horses"  
33          and a logo depicting a horse rearing up on its hind legs.  
34          ...
- 35          (123c) Support NC Education. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle  
36          in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Support  
37          NC Education" with a picture of a mortar board hat and a diploma.  
38          ...
- 39          (124b) Support Soccer. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in  
40          accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Support  
41          Soccer" and a logo designed by the North Carolina Soccer Hall of Fame, Inc.  
42          ...
- 43          (128b) Town of Oak Island. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle.  
44          The plate shall bear the seal of the Town of Oak Island and the letters  
45          "OKI." The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision  
46          unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.

- 48          (129b) Travel and Tourism. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in  
49          accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase  
50          "www.visitnc.com."

1           **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

2           "(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one  
3 registration plate to a recipient of a Legion of Valor award, a 100% disabled veteran, and an  
4 ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional Legion of Valor,  
5 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War plates, are subject to the regular motor vehicle  
6 registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

6 "(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate  
7 and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division  
8 must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a)  
9 among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction  
10 Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under  
11 G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, which is established under  
12 G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

13       **SECTION 4** G.S. 20-81.12(b2) reads as rewritten:

14       "(b2) State Attraction Plates. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a  
15 State attraction plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly  
16 the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of  
17 State attraction plates to the organizations named below in proportion to the number of State  
18 attraction plates sold representing that organization:

19       (1) Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation. – The revenue derived from the special  
20 plate shall be transferred quarterly to Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation for  
21 use in promoting and preserving the Blue Ridge Parkway as a scenic  
22 attraction in North Carolina. A person may obtain from the Division a  
23 special registration plate under this subdivision for the registered owner of a  
24 motor vehicle or a motorcycle. The registration fees and the restrictions on  
25 the issuance of a specialized registration plate for a motorcycle are the same  
26 as for any motor vehicle. The Division must receive a minimum of 300  
27 applications to develop a special registration plate for a motorcycle.

28       ~~(4e)~~(3) Friends of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. – The revenue derived  
29 from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the Friends of the  
30 Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Inc., to be used for educational  
31 materials, preservation programs, capital improvements for the portion of the  
32 Great Smoky Mountains National Park that is located in North Carolina, and  
33 operating expenses of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park.

34       ~~(4g)~~(5) Friends of the Appalachian Trail. – The revenue derived from the special  
35 plate shall be transferred quarterly to The Appalachian Trail Conference to  
36 be used for educational materials, preservation programs, trail maintenance,  
37 trailway and viewshed acquisitions, trailway and viewshed easement  
38 acquisitions, capital improvements for the portions of the Appalachian Trail  
39 and connecting trails that are located in North Carolina, and related  
40 administrative and operating expenses.

41       ~~(4i)~~(7) North Carolina State Parks. – One-half of the revenue derived from the  
42 special plate shall be transferred quarterly to Natural Heritage Trust Fund  
43 established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the remaining revenue shall be  
44 transferred quarterly to the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund established  
45 under G.S. 113-44.15.

46       (9) "Old Baldy," Bald Head Island Lighthouse. – The revenue derived from the  
47 special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the Old Baldy Foundation, Inc.,  
48 for its programs in support of the Bald Head Island Lighthouse.

49       ~~(4j)~~(11) The North Carolina Aquariums. – The revenue derived from the special  
50 plate shall be transferred quarterly to the North Carolina Aquarium Society,  
51 Inc., for its programs in support of the North Carolina Aquariums.



1           ~~(1m)~~(13) The North Carolina Arboretum. – The revenue derived from the special  
2           plate shall be transferred quarterly to The North Carolina Arboretum Society  
3           and used to help the Society obtain grants for the North Carolina Arboretum  
4           and for capital improvements to the North Carolina Arboretum.

5           ~~(1p)~~(15) The North Carolina Maritime Museum. – The revenue derived from the  
6           special plate shall be transferred quarterly to Friends of the Museum, North  
7           Carolina Maritime Museum, Inc., to be used for educational programs and  
8           conservation programs and for operating expenses of the North Carolina  
9           Maritime Museum.

10          ~~(1t)~~(17) The North Carolina Museum of Natural Sciences. – The revenue derived  
11          from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the Friends of the  
12          North Carolina State Museum of Natural Sciences for its programs in  
13          support of the museum.

14          ~~(2)~~(20) The North Carolina Zoological Society. – The revenue derived from the  
15          special plate shall be transferred quarterly to The North Carolina Zoological  
16          Society, Incorporated, to be used for educational programs and conservation  
17          programs at the North Carolina Zoo at Asheboro and for operating expenses  
18          of the North Carolina Zoo at Asheboro."

19          **SECTION 5.** G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

20          "~~(b73)~~ Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
21          applications for the Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden plate before the plate may be developed.  
22          The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate  
23          Account derived from the sale of Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden plates to the Daniel Stowe  
24          Botanical Garden Foundation, Inc., to provide funding for the Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden  
25          outreach program.

26          (b74) NC Wildlife Federation. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for  
27          the NC Wildlife Federation plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer  
28          quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the  
29          sale of NC Wildlife Federation plates to the North Carolina Wildlife Federation, Inc., to  
30          provide funding for a grassroots program to involve anglers, hunters, and wildlife enthusiasts in  
31          conservation issues affecting North Carolina.

32          (b75) North Carolina Master Gardener. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
33          applications for the North Carolina Master Gardener plate before the plate may be developed.  
34          The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate  
35          Account derived from the sale of North Carolina Master Gardener plates to the Master  
36          Gardener's Endowment fund maintained by the Agricultural Foundation of North Carolina  
37          State University, to be used for educational programs by trained volunteers who work in  
38          partnership with their county Cooperative Extension offices to extend information in consumer  
39          horticulture.

40          (b76) Support NC Education. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for  
41          the Support NC Education plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer  
42          quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the  
43          sale of Support NC Education plates to the Board of Governors of The University of North  
44          Carolina to be used to provide scholarship funding at the 16 constituent universities of The  
45          University of North Carolina.

46          (b77) Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for  
47          the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall  
48          transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived  
49          from the sale of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity plates to the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc., to  
50          provide funding for scholarships, education and professional development, or similar programs.

1 None of the proceeds from this special plate may be distributed to any board member as  
2 compensation or as an honorarium.

3 (b78) Travel and Tourism. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the  
4 Travel and Tourism plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer  
5 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the  
6 sale of Travel and Tourism plates to the Division of Tourism, Film, and Sports Development to  
7 be used for programs in support of travel and tourism in North Carolina.

8 (b79) Home of American Golf. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for  
9 the Home of American Golf plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must  
10 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived  
11 from the sale of Home of American Golf plates to the Given Memorial Library, Inc., to provide  
12 funding for the Given Memorial Library – The Tufts Archives.

13 (b80) Carolinas Golf Association. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications  
14 for the Carolinas Golf Association plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall  
15 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived  
16 from the sale of Carolinas Golf Association plates to the Carolinas Golf Association to be used  
17 to promote amateur golf in North Carolina.

18 (b81) NC Horse Council. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the  
19 NC Horse Council plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer  
20 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the  
21 sale of NC Horse Council plates to the North Carolina Horse Council, Inc., to promote and  
22 enhance the equine industry in North Carolina.

23 (b82) Support Soccer. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the  
24 Support Soccer plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly  
25 the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of  
26 Support Soccer plates to the North Carolina Soccer Hall of Fame, Inc., to provide funding to  
27 promote the sport of soccer in North Carolina.

28 (b83) Jaycees. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the Jaycees plate  
29 before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the  
30 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Jaycees plates to the  
31 North Carolina JCI Senate, Inc., to be used to support and underwrite Jaycee activities in North  
32 Carolina.

33 (b84) First in Turf. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the First in  
34 Turf plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money  
35 in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of First in Turf  
36 plates to the Center for Environmental Turfgrass Research at North Carolina State University  
37 for its programs.

38 (b85) Boy Scouts of America. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for  
39 the Boy Scouts of America plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer  
40 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the  
41 sale of Boy Scouts of America plates to the Old Hickory Council of the Boy Scouts of  
42 America, where the proceeds will be divided equally among the Boy Scouts of America  
43 Councils in this State to be used for educational programs, preservation programs, capital  
44 improvements on facilities located in this State, and related administrative and operating  
45 expenses.

46 (b86) Girl Scouts. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the Girl  
47 Scouts plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money  
48 in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Girl Scouts  
49 plates to the Girl Scouts North Carolina Coastal Pines, where the proceeds will be divided  
50 equally among the officially chartered Girl Scout Councils in this State to be used for

1 educational programs, preservation programs, capital improvements on facilities located in this  
2 State, and related administrative and operating expenses.

3 (b87) S.T.A.R. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the S.T.A.R.  
4 plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the  
5 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of S.T.A.R. plates to  
6 Save the Animals Rescue, Inc., to provide funding to rescue distressed horses.

7 (b88) P.E.O. Sisterhood. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the  
8 P.E.O. Sisterhood plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer  
9 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the  
10 sale of P.E.O. Sisterhood plates to P.E.O. International to be used for scholarships for young  
11 women."

12 **SECTION 6.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
