 22 ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional Legion of Valor,
 23 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War plates, are subject to the regular motor vehicle
 24 registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

37 "(b2) State Attraction Plates. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a
38 State attraction plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly
39 the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of
40 State attraction plates to the organizations named below in proportion to the number of State
41 attraction plates sold representing that organization:

- 42 (1) Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation. – The revenue derived from the special
43 plate shall be transferred quarterly to Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation for
44 use in promoting and preserving the Blue Ridge Parkway as a scenic
45 attraction in North Carolina. A person may obtain from the Division a
46 special registration plate under this subdivision for the registered owner of a
47 motor vehicle or a motorcycle. The registration fees and the restrictions on
48 the issuance of a specialized registration plate for a motorcycle are the same
49 as for any motor vehicle. The Division must receive a minimum of 300
50 applications to develop a special registration plate for a motorcycle.

2 from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the Friends of the
3 Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Inc., to be used for educational

5 Great Smoky Mountains National Park that is located in North Carolina, and
6 operating expenses of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park.

8 plate shall be transferred quarterly to The Appalachian Trail Conference to
9 be used for educational materials, preservation programs, trail maintenance,

26 plate shall be transferred quarterly to The North Carolina Arboretum Society
27 and used to help the Society obtain grants for the North Carolina Arboretum

45 applications for the Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden plate before the plate may be developed.

47 Account derived from the sale of Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden plates to the Daniel Stowe
48 Botanical Garden Foundation, Inc., to provide funding for the Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden
49 outreach program.

50 (b74) NC Wildlife Federation. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
51 the NC Wildlife Federation plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer

1 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
2 sale of NC Wildlife Federation plates to the North Carolina Wildlife Federation, Inc., to
3 provide funding for a grassroots program to involve anglers, hunters, and wildlife enthusiasts in
4 conservation issues affecting North Carolina.

5 (b75) North Carolina Master Gardener. – The Division must receive 300 or more
6 applications for the North Carolina Master Gardener plate before the plate may be developed.
7 The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate
8 Account derived from the sale of North Carolina Master Gardener plates to the Master
9 Gardener's Endowment fund maintained by the Agricultural Foundation of North Carolina
10 State University, to be used for educational programs by trained volunteers who work in
11 partnership with their county Cooperative Extension offices to extend information in consumer
12 horticulture.

13 (b76) Support NC Education. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
14 the Support NC Education plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
15 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
16 sale of Support NC Education plates to the Board of Governors of The University of North
17 Carolina to be used to provide scholarship funding at the 16 constituent universities of The
18 University of North Carolina.

19 (b77) Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
20 the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall
21 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
22 from the sale of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity plates to the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc., to
23 provide funding for scholarships, education and professional development, or similar programs.
24 None of the proceeds from this special plate may be distributed to any board member as
25 compensation or as an honorarium.

26 (b78) Travel and Tourism. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
27 Travel and Tourism plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
28 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
29 sale of Travel and Tourism plates to the Division of Tourism, Film, and Sports Development to
30 be used for programs in support of travel and tourism in North Carolina.

31 (b79) Home of American Golf. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
32 the Home of American Golf plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must
33 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
34 from the sale of Home of American Golf plates to the Given Memorial Library, Inc., to provide
35 funding for the Given Memorial Library – The Tufts Archives.

36 (b80) Carolinas Golf Association. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications
37 for the Carolinas Golf Association plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall
38 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
39 from the sale of Carolinas Golf Association plates to the Carolinas Golf Association to be used
40 to promote amateur golf in North Carolina.

41 (b81) NC Horse Council. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
42 NC Horse Council plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
43 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
44 sale of NC Horse Council plates to the North Carolina Horse Council, Inc., to promote and
45 enhance the equine industry in North Carolina.

46 (b82) Support Soccer. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
47 Support Soccer plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly
48 the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of
49 Support Soccer plates to the North Carolina Soccer Hall of Fame, Inc., to provide funding to
50 promote the sport of soccer in North Carolina.

1 **(b83) Jaycees.** – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the Jaycees plate
2 before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the
3 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Jaycees plates to the
4 North Carolina JCI Senate, Inc., to be used to support and underwrite Jaycee activities in North
5 Carolina.

6 **(b84) First in Turf.** – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the First in
7 Turf plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money
8 in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of First in Turf
9 plates to the Center for Environmental Turfgrass Research at North Carolina State University
10 for its programs.

11 **(b85) Boy Scouts of America.** – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
12 the Boy Scouts of America plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
13 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
14 sale of Boy Scouts of America plates to the Old Hickory Council of the Boy Scouts of
15 America, where the proceeds will be divided equally among the Boy Scouts of America
16 Councils in this State to be used for educational programs, preservation programs, capital
17 improvements on facilities located in this State, and related administrative and operating
18 expenses.

19 **(b86) Girl Scouts.** – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the Girl
20 Scouts plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money
21 in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Girl Scouts
22 plates to the Girl Scouts North Carolina Coastal Pines, where the proceeds will be divided
23 equally among the officially chartered Girl Scout Councils in this State to be used for
24 educational programs, preservation programs, capital improvements on facilities located in this
25 State, and related administrative and operating expenses.

26 **(b87) S.T.A.R.** – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the S.T.A.R.
27 plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the
28 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of S.T.A.R. plates to
29 Save the Animals Rescue, Inc., to provide funding to rescue distressed horses.

30 **(b88) P.E.O. Sisterhood.** – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
31 P.E.O. Sisterhood plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
32 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
33 sale of P.E.O. Sisterhood plates to P.E.O. International to be used for scholarships for young
34 women.

35 **(b89) Retired Piedmont Airlines Employee.** – The Division must receive 300 or more
36 applications for a Retired Piedmont Airlines Employee plate before the plate may be
37 developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural
38 Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Retired Piedmont Airlines Employee plates
39 to Piedmont Silver Eagles Charitable Funds, Inc., to be used for scholarships and family
40 assistance for retired Piedmont Airlines employees and their families, including surviving
41 spouses and dependents, suffering economic hardship.

42 **(b90) North Carolina Emergency Management Association.** – The Division must receive
43 300 or more applications for the North Carolina Emergency Management Association plate
44 before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the
45 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of North Carolina
46 Emergency Management Association plates to the North Carolina Emergency Management
47 Association to be used for training and education purposes."

48 **SECTION 6.** G.S. 20-79.4(130) reads as rewritten:

49 "(130) U.S. Navy ~~Specialty~~ Submarine Veteran. – Issuable to a veteran of the
50 United States Navy ~~Submariner~~ Submarine Service. The plate shall bear the
51 phrase "~~Silent Service~~ United States Navy Submarine Veteran" and shall bear

1 a representation of the Submarine Service Qualification ~~pin~~-insignia overlaid
2 upon a representation of the State of North Carolina. The Division may not
3 issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least ~~300~~
4 150 applications for the plate."

SECTION 7. This act is effective when it becomes law.
