A BILL TO BE ENTITLED	
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR NATIONAL SOCIETY TO PREVENT BLINDNESS – NORTH CAROLINA AFFILIATE, INC. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated to National Society to Prevent Blindness – North Carolina Affiliate, Inc., in the following amounts: (1) \$150,000 to provide vision screening for children enrolled in the More at Four program, Head Start, or Title 1 Pre-K. (2) \$150,000 to support critical needs in the Kenneth C. Royall Jr. Vision Screening Improvement Program to meet additional demands for training	
S	and materials resulting from increased early childhood vision screening requirements. ECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
