A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO EXEMPT THE CITY OF GREENSBORO FROM THE REQUIREMENT THAT
3 CERTAIN WILD ANIMALS TAKEN UNDER A DEPREDATION PERMIT MUST BE
4 EUTHANIZED OR RELEASED ON THE PROPERTY WHERE CAPTURED AND
5 AUTHORIZE THE RELOCATION OF THOSE ANIMALS TO A SUITABLE
6 ALTERNATIVE HABITAT.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of 15A NCAC 10B.0106(d)(5) or
9 any other provision of law, wild animals of the order Carnivora and beaver that have been
10 taken alive under a depredation permit may be relocated to a suitable alternative habitat with
11 the consent of the landowner of that new habitat.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to the City of Greensboro.

13 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
