2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE
3 TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT
4 SYSTEM WITHOUT PROVIDING PRIOR SERVICE CREDITS TO ITS EMPLOYEES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if the Housing Authority
7 of the City of Charlotte becomes a member of the Local Governmental Employees' Retirement
8 System, the authority board may elect to provide no prior service credit in the Retirement
9 System for employees employed prior to the date that the authority becomes a participating
10 employer in the Retirement System, and no prior service credit will be given for employees of
11 the authority for service provided to the town prior to its participation in the Retirement
12 System, nor shall the town be required to pay for any prior service credits for its employees.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to the Housing Authority of the City of
14 Charlotte.

15 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
