SENATE BILL 64

Short Title: Motorcycle Learner's Permit. (Public)

Sponsors: Senators Brown and Rand.

Referred to: Judiciary I.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO SHORTEN THE DURATION AND AMEND THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A
3 MOTORCYCLE LEARNER'S PERMIT, AND CLARIFY THE REQUIREMENTS FOR
4 OBTAINING A MOTORCYCLE ENDORSEMENT.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-7(a1) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a1) Motorcycles and Mopeds. – To drive a motorcycle, a person shall ~~have~~have one of
8 the following:

- 9 (1) A full provisional license with a motorcycle learner's ~~permit~~permit.
10 (2) A regular drivers license with a motorcycle learner's ~~permit~~or permit.
11 (3) ~~Either~~:
12 a. A full provisional ~~license~~license with a motorcycle endorsement.
13 b.
14 (4) A regular drivers license, with a motorcycle endorsement.

15 To obtain a motorcycle endorsement, a person shall demonstrate competence to drive a
16 motorcycle by passing a riding skills test administered by the Division or by providing proof of
17 successful completion of the North Carolina Motorcycle Safety Education Program Basic Rider
18 Course or Experienced Rider Course. The person shall pay the fee set in subsection (i) of this
19 section for a motorcycle endorsement. Subsection (a2) of this section sets forth the
20 requirements for a motorcycle learner's permit.

21 ~~To obtain a motorcycle endorsement, a person shall demonstrate competence to drive a~~
22 ~~motorcycle by:~~

- 23 (1) ~~Passing a road test;~~
24 (2) ~~Passing a written or oral test concerning motorcycles; and~~
25 (3) ~~Paying the fee for a motorcycle endorsement.~~

26 Neither a drivers license nor a motorcycle endorsement is required to drive a moped."

27 SECTION 2. G.S. 20-7(a2) reads as rewritten:

28 "(a2) Motorcycle Learner's Permit. – The following persons are eligible for a motorcycle
29 learner's permit:

- 30 (1) A person who is at least 16 years old but less than 18 years old and has a full
31 provisional license issued by the Division.
32 (2) A person who is at least 18 years old and has a license issued by the
33 Division.

34 To obtain a motorcycle learner's permit, an applicant shall pass a vision test, a road sign
35 test, and a written test specified by the Division. An applicant who is less than 18 years old, or
36 any applicant who has held a valid drivers license for less than two years, shall successfully
37 complete the North Carolina Motorcycle Safety Education Program Basic Rider Course. A



1 motorcycle learner's permit expires ~~18 months~~ six months after it is ~~issued~~ issued and may be
2 renewed for one additional six-month period. The holder of a motorcycle learner's permit may
3 not drive a motorcycle with a passenger. The fee for a motorcycle learner's permit is the
4 amount set in G.S. 20-7(1) for a learner's permit."

5 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
