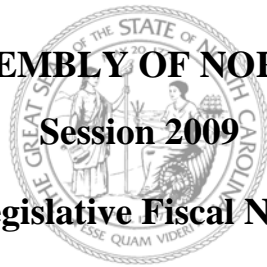

BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 886 enacts new GS 90-370 as the title indicates. Allows the Board to assess the cost of a disciplinary action against a licensee or person found to be in violation of Article 25 of GS Chapter 90 or of rules adopted by the Board. Effective October 1, 2009, and applies to acts or omissions committed on or after that date

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

House Bill 886 allows the North Carolina Board of Dietetics/Nutrition to recover the costs of disciplinary action against a licensee. This will result in an increase in revenues for all fiscal years. According to the Board, the number and nature of disciplinary issues it will process each year cannot be predicted. Because the amount the Board is able to recover depends on the number and nature of the disciplinary issues it processes, the size of this revenue increase cannot be determined.
