SESSION LAW 2011-243  
HOUSE BILL 271

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE PROHIBITION AGAINST CARRYING A CONCEALED WEAPON DOES NOT APPLY TO STATE PROBATION AND PAROLE CERTIFIED OFFICERS WHEN THEY ARE OFF-DUTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-269(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(6) State probation or parole certified officers, when off-duty, provided that an officer does not carry a concealed weapon while consuming alcohol or an unlawful controlled substance or while alcohol or an unlawful controlled substance remains in the officer's body."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2011.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2011.
