A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE LAW THAT AUTHORIZES IN-STATE TUITION STATUS
FOR OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS WHO ARE AWARDED FULL SCHOLARSHIPS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 116-143.6 is repealed.

SECTION 2. The repeal of G.S. 116-143.6 by Section 1 of this act does not affect the receipt of full scholarships by students who received the scholarships prior to the effective date except as follows: a student's eligibility for in-State tuition provided pursuant to G.S. 116-143.6 is limited to a cumulative total of eight academic semesters.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
