

1 the Commission. Clerical staff shall be furnished to the Commission through the offices of the
2 House of Representatives and Senate Supervisors of Clerks.

3 **SECTION 5.** Meeting location. – The Commission may meet in the Legislative
4 Building or Legislative Office Building upon the approval of the Legislative Services
5 Commission.

6 **SECTION 6.** Expenses of members. – Members of the Commission shall receive
7 per diem, subsistence, and travel allowances at the rate established in G.S. 120-3.1.

8 **SECTION 7.** Report. – The Commission shall submit an interim report to the 2012
9 Regular Session of the 2011 General Assembly prior to its reconvening and shall make a final
10 report to the 2013 Regular Session of the General Assembly prior to its convening. The report
11 shall contain the Commission's findings, recommendations, legislative proposals, and cost
12 analyses. The Commission shall terminate upon filing its final report or upon the convening of
13 the 2013 General Assembly, whichever is earlier.

14 **SECTION 8.** Funding. – Of the funds appropriated to the General Assembly for
15 the 2011-2012 fiscal year and for the 2012-2013 fiscal year, the Legislative Services
16 Commission shall allocate funds for the purpose of supporting the study established by this act.

17 **SECTION 9.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2011.
