A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT ADOPTING THE HERRING FESTIVAL HELD IN THE TOWN OF
JAMESVILLE AS THE OFFICIAL HERRING FESTIVAL OF THE STATE OF NORTH
CAROLINA.

Whereas, since 1949 the Town of Jamesville in Martin County has held an annual
Herring Festival each spring; and

Whereas, the Herring Festival is a vital fundraiser for the Town of Jamesville,
Jamesville Fire Department, Jamesville Rescue Department, Jamesville Ruritan Club, and
many local businesses and residents; and

Whereas, the Herring Festival serves as a celebration of the heritage that was once
an important way of life in the area; and

Whereas, the Herring Festival offers visitors many family-oriented activities, such
as a parade, arts and crafts, rides, games, live music, and local foods and traditions; and

Whereas, each year, citizens in the area demonstrate their community pride by
volunteering to make the festival a success; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
section to read:

"§ 145-34. State herring festival.

The Herring Festival held in the Town of Jamesville is adopted as the official herring
festival of the State of North Carolina."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
