2 (3) The date the prescription was written.  
3 (4) The date the prescription was filled.  
4 (5) The prescription number.  
5 (6) Whether the prescription is new or a refill.  
6 (7) Metric quantity of the dispensed drug.  
7 (8) Estimated days of supply of dispensed drug, if provided to the dispenser.  
8 (9) National Drug Code of dispensed drug.  
9 (10) Prescriber's DEA number."

10 **SECTION 2.** Article 5E of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by  
11 adding a new section to read:

12 "**§ 90-113.74A. Mandatory use of controlled substances reporting system.**

13 (a) Each person authorized to prescribe or dispense a controlled substance for the  
14 purpose of providing medical or pharmaceutical care for a patient shall, prior to prescribing or  
15 dispensing a controlled substance, review all information contained in the controlled substances  
16 reporting system pertaining to the patient for the preceding 12-month period to determine if the  
17 prescription is medically necessary and appropriate. This section does not apply to an  
18 emergency situation in which immediate action is necessary to preserve the life or health of a  
19 patient.

20 (b) The Commission may adopt rules as necessary to implement this section."

21 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2011.
