6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **PART I. SPEAKER'S RECOMMENDATIONS**

9 **SECTION 1.1.** William R. Warner of Cumberland County is appointed to the  
10 Fayetteville State University Board of Trustees for a term expiring on June 30, 2021, to fill  
11 unexpired term of Dr. John G. McNeil.

12 **SECTION 1.2.** Bruce B. Friend of Wake County is appointed to the North Carolina  
13 Charter Schools Advisory Board for a term expiring on June 30, 2021, to fill unexpired term of  
14 Joseph Maimone.

15 **SECTION 1.3.(a)** Representative John Torbett is appointed to the Virginia-North  
16 Carolina Interstate High-Speed Rail Compact for a term expiring on June 30, 2020, to fill  
17 unexpired term of Representative Nelson Dollar.

18 **SECTION 1.3.(b)** Representative John Fraley is appointed to the Virginia-North  
19 Carolina Interstate High-Speed Rail Compact for a term expiring on June 30, 2020, to fill  
20 unexpired term of Representative William Brawley.

21 **SECTION 1.4.** Earl W. Willis, Jr., of Chowan County is appointed to the Board of  
22 Directors of the Roanoke Island Historical Association, Inc., for a term expiring on September  
23 30, 2021.

24 **SECTION 1.5.** Matthew Peeler of Perquimans County is appointed to the North  
25 Carolina Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council for a term expiring on December 31,  
26 2019, to fill the unexpired term of Dianne M. Layden.

27 **SECTION 1.6.** Representative Sarah Stevens of Surry County is appointed to the  
28 Permanency Innovation Initiative Oversight Committee for a term expiring on June 30, 2020, to  
29 fill the unexpired term of Representative Jonathan Jordan.
