HOUSE BILL DRH30055-MT-48 (02/07)

Short Title: School Calendar Flex./Certain School Systems. (Local)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FLEXIBILITY TO CERTAIN BOARDS OF  
3 EDUCATION IN ADOPTING THEIR SCHOOL CALENDARS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:

6 "(d) Opening and Closing Dates. – Local boards of education shall determine the dates of  
7 opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. Except for  
8 year-round schools, the opening date for students shall be no earlier than ~~the Monday closest to~~  
9 ~~August 26, and the closing date for students shall be no later than the Friday closest to June 11. On~~  
10 ~~a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive the requirement that the~~  
11 ~~opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26 and may allow the~~  
12 ~~local board of education to set an opening date no earlier than the Monday closest to August 19, to~~  
13 ~~the extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient days to accommodate anticipated~~  
14 ~~makeup days due to school closings. A local board may revise the scheduled closing date if~~  
15 ~~necessary in order to comply with the minimum requirements for instructional days or~~  
16 ~~instructional time. For purposes of this subsection, the term "good cause" means that schools in~~  
17 ~~any local school administrative unit in a county have been closed eight days per year during any~~  
18 ~~four of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures, or~~  
19 ~~other emergency situations.~~August 1.

20 ~~The required opening and closing dates under this subsection shall not apply to any school that~~  
21 ~~a local board designated as having a modified calendar for the 2003-2004 school year or to any~~  
22 ~~school that was part of a planned program in the 2003-2004 school year for a system of modified~~  
23 ~~calendar schools, so long as the school operates under a modified calendar."~~

24 **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to Duplin County Schools, Sampson County  
25 Schools, and Wayne County Schools.

26 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the  
27 2017-2018 school year.
