SENATE BILL DRS45302-LUa-81A (03/15)

Short Title: Funds/Eliminate NC Pre-K Waitlist Statewide. (Public)

Sponsors: Senators Waddell, Woodard, and Van Duyn (Primary Sponsors).

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO ELIMINATE THE WAITLIST FOR THE NC  
3 PRE-KINDERGARTEN (NC PRE-K) PROGRAM STATEWIDE.

4 Whereas, the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services submitted  
5 its annual report on the NC Prekindergarten Program (NC Pre-K) dated March 15, 2016; and

6 Whereas, in the annual report, the Department of Health and Human Services  
7 referenced the results of an annual evaluation of the NC Pre-K program based on the  
8 2014-2015 program year and noted the continued positive outcomes for the 2014-2015 program  
9 year, as well as in previous years; and

10 Whereas, the evaluation specifically noted that "children enrolled in the NC Pre-K  
11 program exhibited significant gains during their pre-k year across all domains of learning"; and

12 Whereas, the evaluation also stated that "children at different levels of English  
13 proficiency and dual-language learners exhibited significant gains across all domains of  
14 learning during their time in the NC Pre-K program"; and

15 Whereas, the evaluation further stated that "growth rates in domains of learning for  
16 children who had enrolled in NC Pre-K were even greater during pre-k than for normal  
17 developmental growth"; and

18 Whereas, all eligible four-year olds should be able to participate in and benefit from  
19 the positive outcomes associated with the NC Pre-K program; Now, therefore,  
20 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

21 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
22 Health and Human Services, Division of Child Development and Early Education, the sum of  
23 twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000) for the 2017-2018 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-four  
24 million four hundred thousand dollars (\$24,400,000) for the 2018-2019 fiscal year to eliminate  
25 the waitlist for the Prekindergarten Program (NC Pre-K) statewide.

26 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2017.
