A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO REPEAL LEGISLATION PERMITTING MUNICIPALITIES TO OPERATE
CHARTER SCHOOLS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The following session laws are repealed:

- (1) S.L. 2018-3.
- (2) Section 38.8 of S.L. 2018-5.
- (3) Section 11.1 of S.L. 2018-97.
- (4) Section 20 of S.L. 2018-145.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. Upon the effective date of this act, the State Board of Education shall terminate the charter of any charter school operated by a municipality.
