A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE TRANSPORTATION EFFICIENCY BUDGET RATING FOR  
CURRITUCK COUNTY SCHOOLS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** For purposes of calculating the transportation efficiency budget rating for a local school administrative unit, the Department of Public Instruction shall include an assumption that the transportation efficiency budget rating is at least fifteen percentage points higher than the actual transportation efficiency budget rating calculated by the Department for that local school administrative unit.

**SECTION 2.** This act applies only to Currituck County Schools.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2019-2020 school year.
