A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO FULLY FUND ENROLLMENT GROWTH AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH  
2 CAROLINA.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 **SECTION 1.(a)** By August 15, 2020, the Department of Commerce shall transfer  
5 the sum of twelve million seven hundred eighteen thousand five hundred seventy-eight dollars  
6 (\$12,718,578) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year from the Job Development  
7 Investment Grant Special Revenue Fund (Budget Code: 24609; Fund Code: 2565) to the Board  
8 of Governors of The University of North Carolina (Budget Code: 16011). The funds transferred  
9 pursuant to this section are hereby appropriated to the Board of Governors of The University of  
10 North Carolina for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to be used to fund enrollment growth at The  
11 University of North Carolina.

12 **SECTION 1.(b)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
13 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of sixteen million six hundred  
14 seventy-three thousand six hundred fifty-three dollars (\$16,673,653) in nonrecurring funds for  
15 the 2020-2021 fiscal year to be used to fund enrollment growth at The University of North  
16 Carolina.

17 **SECTION 1.(c)** Departmental receipts, as defined in G.S. 143C-1-1, are  
18 appropriated for the 2020-2021 fiscal year up to the amounts needed to implement the provisions  
19 in this act for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.

20 **SECTION 2.** The provisions of the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the General  
21 Statutes, are reenacted and shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated in this act  
22 by reference.

23 **SECTION 3.** Except where expressly repealed or amended by this act, the provisions  
24 of any other legislation enacted during the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly  
25 expressly appropriating funds to an agency, a department, or an institution covered under this act  
26 shall remain in effect.

27 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2020.
