2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO NORTH CAROLINA STATE UNIVERSITY FOR A
3 PILOT PROGRAM IN WAKE COUNTY TO INCREASE DIVERSITY IN THE GAME
4 OF PICKLEBALL.
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors
7 of The University of North Carolina the nonrecurring sum of ten thousand one hundred twelve
8 dollars (\$10,112) for the 2022-2023 fiscal year to be allocated to the Department of Parks,
9 Recreation and Tourism Management in the College of Natural Resources at North Carolina State
10 University for a pilot program located in Wake County promoting the sport of pickleball. The
11 purpose of the pilot program is to promote a sport with a variety of public health benefits,
12 including physical activity, social and community connections, and psychological well-being, in
13 a competitive setting that is multiculturally and socioeconomically inclusive and that has low
14 cost of entry and high ease-of-play. The pilot shall consist of the following: (i) at least two focus
15 groups conducted to gain insight into how to best create and promote the program and to increase
16 diversity among pickleball participants, (ii) creation of a branded introduction to the program and
17 sport, including name, logo, and physical and digital marketing materials, (iii) marketing of the
18 program, with or without community partners, using websites, social media, direct email, event
19 days, and demonstrations, (iv) a four-week session held both in the fall of 2022 and the spring of
20 2023 at the recreation centers in Raleigh located on Method Road and Chavis Park, and (v)
21 post-program evaluation and creation of a toolkit that can be used to implement similar programs
22 for parks and recreation departments and other community organizations. Funds appropriated in
23 this section do not revert but remain available to the Department for the purposes provided herein.
24 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
