Short Title: Address Pandemic Learning Loss/Alamance Cnty. (Local)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO ADDRESS PANDEMIC LEARNING LOSS BY TEMPORARILY ALLOWING  
3 ADDITIONAL ADJUSTMENTS TO THE SCHOOL CALENDAR FOR  
4 ALAMANCE-BURLINGTON SCHOOLS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:

7 "(d) Opening and Closing Dates. – Local boards of education shall determine the dates of  
8 opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. ~~Except for~~  
9 ~~year-round schools, the opening date for students shall be no earlier than the Monday closest to~~  
10 ~~August 26, and the closing date for students shall be no later than the Friday closest to June 11.~~  
11 ~~On a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive the requirement that the~~  
12 ~~opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26 and may allow the~~  
13 ~~local board of education to set an opening date no earlier than the Monday closest to August 19,~~  
14 ~~to the extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient days to accommodate anticipated~~  
15 ~~makeup days due to school closings. A local board may revise the scheduled closing date if~~  
16 ~~necessary in order to comply with the minimum requirements for instructional days or~~  
17 ~~instructional time. For purposes of this subsection, the term "good cause" means that schools in~~  
18 ~~any local school administrative unit in a county have been closed eight days per year during any~~  
19 ~~four of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures,~~  
20 ~~or other emergency situations.~~

21 ~~The required opening and closing dates under this subsection shall not apply to any school~~  
22 ~~that a local board designated as having a modified calendar for the 2003-2004 school year or to~~  
23 ~~any school that was part of a planned program in the 2003-2004 school year for a system of~~  
24 ~~modified calendar schools, so long as the school operates under a modified calendar."~~

25 SECTION 2. This act applies only to Alamance-Burlington Schools.

26 SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and expires at the conclusion  
27 of the 2022-2023 school year.
