A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW CAMPUS POLICE AGENCIES OF THE CONSTITUENT  
INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO SELL, TRADE, OR  
OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF ANY OR ALL SURPLUS WEAPONS IN THEIR  
POSSESSION TO ANY FEDERALLY LICENSED FIREARM DEALER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 143-63.1(d) reads as rewritten:

"(d) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, but subject to the provisions of  
G.S. 20-187.2, the North Carolina State Highway Patrol, the North Carolina Division of Adult  
Correction and Juvenile Justice of the Department of Public Safety, the Alcohol Law  
Enforcement Division of the Department of Public Safety, campus police agencies of the  
constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina, and the North Carolina State Bureau  
of Investigation may sell, trade, or otherwise dispose of any or all surplus weapons they possess  
to any federally licensed firearm dealers. The sale, trade, or disposal of these weapons shall be  
in a manner prescribed by the Department of Administration. Any moneys or property obtained  
from the sale, trade, or disposal shall go to the general fund."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
