A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION TO STUDY THE  
FEASIBILITY AND POTENTIAL OUTCOMES OF A STATEWIDE YEAR-ROUND  
SCHOOL CALENDAR.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** The Department of Public Instruction shall study and make  
recommendations on the feasibility and potential outcomes of a statewide year-round school year,  
including analysis of the following:

- (1) Educational outcomes.
- (2) Summer learning loss.
- (3) Testing administration.
- (4) Dual enrollment in community college courses for high school students.
- (5) Travel and tourism participation and revenues.
- (6) Seasonal employment.
- (7) Extracurricular learning opportunities and camps.
- (8) Scheduling for families and communities.
- (9) Implementation considerations.
- (10) Building Utilization
- (11) Any other area the Department deems relevant to the feasibility and potential  
outcomes of a statewide year-round calendar.

**SECTION 2.** The Department of Public Instruction shall submit a report on the  
results of its study, including any proposed legislation, to the Joint Legislative Education  
Oversight Committee no later than 180 days after the date this act becomes law.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.



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
